When someone is talking, we close our iPads and lay them face down so we can give our full attention.



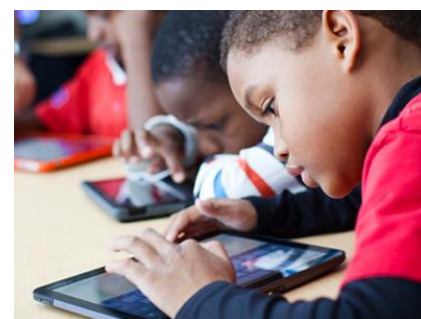
Our hands are always **clean** when we are using an iPad.
